### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Previous experience working with children in a group setting.
- Must have a desire to work with children in a nursery/toddler environment
- At least 18 years of age
- CPR, First Aid, AED certifications and Child Abuse Prevention Training (upon hire).
- Previous experience with diverse populations preferred.

### **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Communicate effectively with co-workers, director, and other staff.
- Provide proper discipline when necessary follow the Cane Bay Family YMCA disciplinary policy.
- Have complete knowledge of emergency procedures to ensure the safety of the children.
- Attend all staff meetings and training programs.
- Maintain an attitude of professionalism and loyalty.
- Responsible for participating in all activities with the children.
- Share responsibilities with co-workers each day (music, arts, and crafts, playground).
- Set up and break down room each day, clean up areas, and return materials to storage area.
- Maintain a clean environment.
- Must have an attitude of safety in every aspect of the program including, but not limited to check in/out, playground, bathroom, free play, programmed activities, and transitions times.
- Be able to work mornings, late afternoons into evening, weekends.
